

THAWED EMBRYO TRANSFER

Definition: If the couple has frozen embryos it does not have to repeat the complete In Vitro Fertilisation cycle. The embryos are thawed at the time of transfer to the woman and are transferred in the same way as fresh embryos.

Indication: Couples who have already carried out an In Vitro Fertilisation cycle and whose non-transferred embryos were frozen and stored at the time.

Advantages: In these cases only the last phase of the In Vitro Fertilisation cycle is carried out, which significantly reduces the costs.
